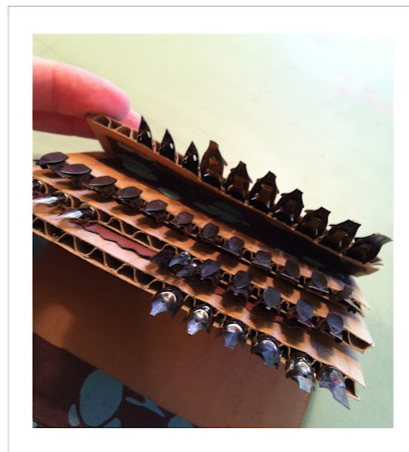
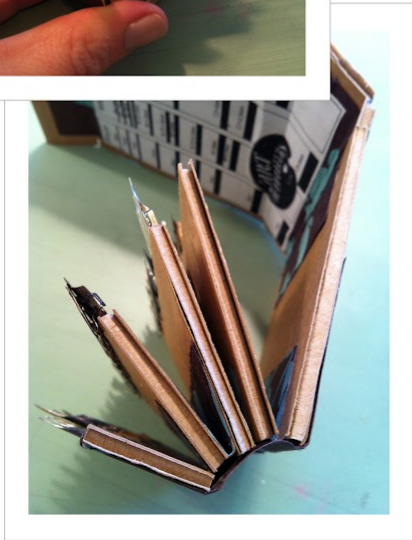

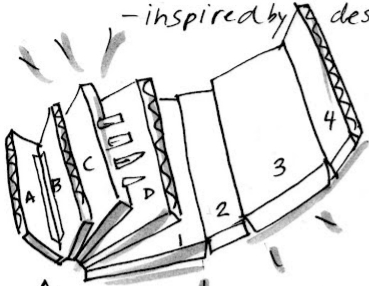
- materials -
- non-slip metal ruler, mech. pencil.
 - letter sized sheet of corrugated cardboard.
 - Xacto blade, scissors, cutting mat
 - tape (cloth, bookbinders, duct, carpet, etc.)



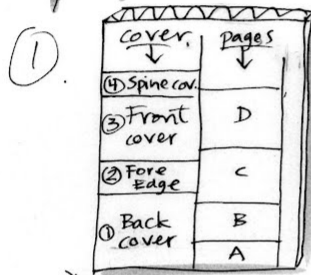

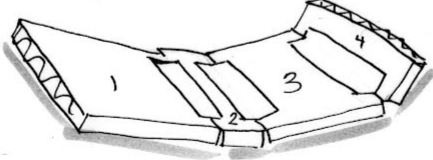
- materials -**
- non-slip metal ruler, mech. pencil.
 - letter sized sheet of corrugated cardboard.
 - Xacto blade, scissors, cutting mat
 - tape (cloth, bookbinders, duct, carpet, etc.)



1. Draw template onto cardboard with a vertical grain. Start in *left corner & measure out.
 - Label all pieces.
 - Cut out pieces & discard scraps.

2. Tape all cover pieces together (1-4) as shown in diagram. Fit them tightly together w/ no gaps in between pieces.

Tape is on one side only, so the book folds in one direction, in on itself.

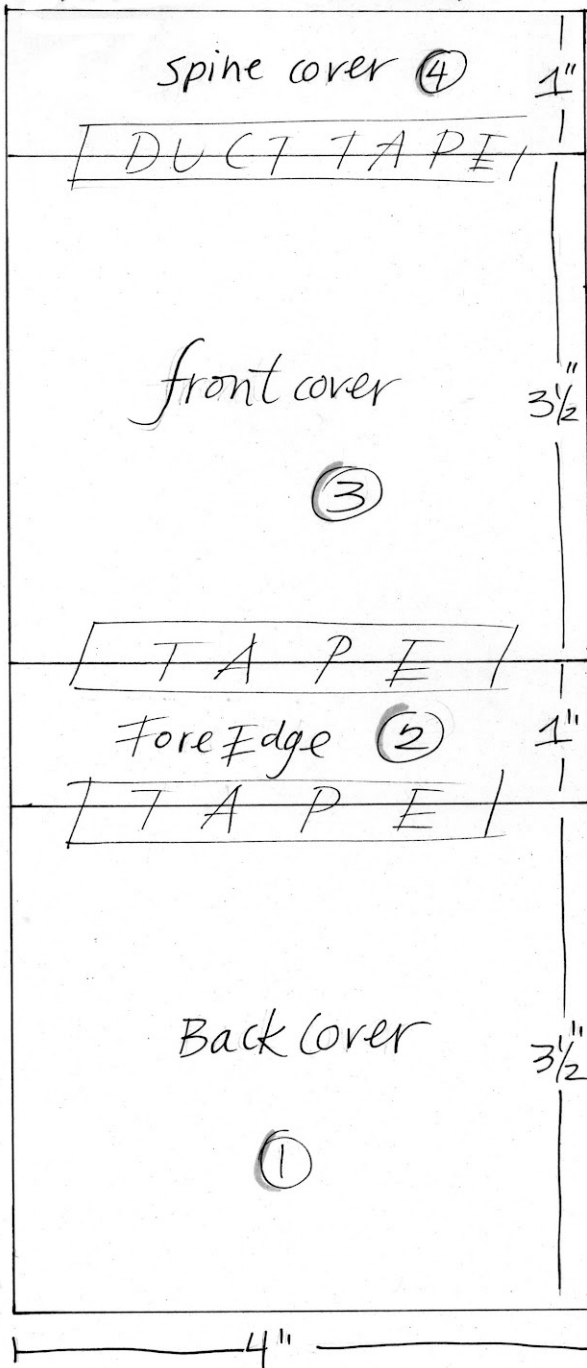


3. Tape pages A-D together in order as seen in diagram, so they flip just like a book.

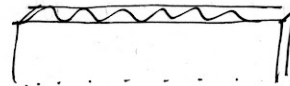
step 3-B. Tape pages & cover together by taping over spine & wrapping it around to back cover.

4. fin! All is good & well. Secure w/ Rubberband.

Remember to cut out pieces with a vertical grain so that nibs will fit in slots at tops of all pages.
