Workshop supply list

Essentials

- 2 to 3 lead pencils, e.g. 2B, B, HB, 2H, 4H (not charcoal)
- black waterproof pen (any size), e.g. Pigma Micron
- white coloured pencil and/or white wax crayon
- favourite writing tools:
 - at least 2 to 3 traditional tools, i.e., pen nibs (and holders), pointed brushes, chisel-edged brushes, ruling writers, etc.
 - at least 1 funky tool, i.e., ruling writer, cola pen, comb pen, twig, shell, etc.
- 2 to 3 mixing brushes
- palette with 6 to 12 wells
- 2 plastic containers (wide enough to accommodate largest tool), 2 rinse containers
- scissors, cutting knife with fresh blade, cutting mat (at least 8.5 x 11")
- ruler or triangle for cutting edge and for squaring up (at least 12")
- PVA glue plus glue brush and/or glue stick
- paper towels or rags
- trash bag or plastic sheet to protect table
- several sheets of scrap paper
- note-taking materials

Optional

Unless you own it, please don't buy it. We can share.

- Dr. Martin's Pen White
- palette with watercolours or gouache
- pointed brush, size 0 or 1
- paint brush, 2 to 4" (whatever size you have)
- removable tape or masking tape, any width(s)
- white china marker (this is a waxy pencil used for marking china dishes)
- bookbinding tools such as needle, bone folder, awl
- one quote (50 words maximum) that you want to use as inspiration (Lily will bring quotes related to freewheeling)

Materials fee (amount to be determined)

- colour handouts, writing media, bookbinding supplies, consumables, Arches Cover and Arches 140 lb HP watercolour paper
