

## Brush Roman Capitals – Beginners with Tasha de Guzman

Roman Capitals is the basis of all western modern calligraphy and typography today. Its most notable example being the Trajan Inscription on the Trajan Column in Rome. In this course, we will acquaint our hand with Roman Capitals using the flat brush. We will learn how to hold and manipulate our tool of choice to produce letters with efficiency of strokes.

A knowledge of basic Roman Capitals proportion is advised, as we will be focusing our attention on the brush. We will, however, cover this quickly during introduction. (Tasha uses the Winsor & Newton 995)
- 1" flat brush
- sketch, kraft, or butcher paper roll (12")
- sumi ink
- white gouache (plus, your preferred colours)
- palettes (large)
- pencils, eraser, ruler
